LEON COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR SERVICE CENTERS TO REOPEN

June 1, 2020

TALLAHASSEE, FL – Doris Maloy, Leon County Tax Collector, is pleased to announce that on June 1, 2020, the tax collector service centers will reopen to the public. (The reopening of the Neil Kirkman Service Center at 2900 Apalachee Parkway is contingent upon the reopening of state office buildings pursuant to the Executive Order of Governor Desantis). The service centers have been closed due to COVID-19, and as a result services that required “the customer to be present” could not be provided. Therefore, when service centers reopen, priority will be given to services such as driver licenses and vehicle titling. Customers are encouraged to continue to use drop box, mail in, or online options to renew registrations for motor vehicles, vessels or mobile homes or to pay property taxes. Concealed weapon renewals only will be available at the Metropolitan Service Center.

Mrs. Maloy emphasized, “The safety of our employees and the public is our primary concern; therefore, customers can expect to see some changes in the way we operate as we adjust to the reality of social/physical distancing”. Office staff will be available to answer questions and provide directional guidance as the following health and safety protocols will be in effect:

- All service center employees will wear a face mask.
- Only person(s) transacting business will be allowed in a service center.
- Customers will be required to wear a face mask to enter and be served in a service center.
- Customers will be required to maintain 6 ft. social distancing while in a service center.

Mrs. Maloy concluded by saying, “As we follow the CDC guidelines to help stop the spread of COVID-19, we will continue to improve upon our processes to ensure the safety of our employees and customers”.
